

July 10-14 – STEAM2 Academy: Nature Camp! - registration code 106637

Campers will create an array of beautiful art projects – including a pastels piece inspired by Van Gogh’s famous “Sunflowers” painting. We will use a microscope and magnifying glasses to take a closer look at flowers, branches, and leaves. This week will also involve planting our own seeds and discussing the natural process of plant growth. Campers should bring a healthy snack.
