June 20-24 – STEAM2 Academy Presents Nature Camp! – Activity Code 100459

Campers will create an array of beautiful art projects – including a pastels piece inspired by Van Gogh’s famous “Sunflowers” piece. We will use a microscope and magnifying glasses to take closer looks at flowers, branches, and leaves. This week will also involve planting our own seeds and discussing the natural process of plant growth. Campers should bring a healthy snack.

June 27-July1 – STEAM2 Academy Presents Space Camp! – Activity Code 100460

Students construct and launch a model rocket, design their own solar system models, learn the ins and outs of an amateur telescope, paint a constellation masterpiece, create their very own Mars mission rover using recycled materials, and much more! Campers should bring a healthy snack.

July 18-22 – STEAM2 Academy Presents Insect Camp! – Activity Code 100458

Participants will use “real” magnifying glasses to look at insects in slides and learn more about these intriguing creatures. We will learn some fun “bug” songs, dance to the tune of Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov’s “Flight of the Bumblebee”, trace insects, make some rock art, create clay insects, and the list continues. Campers should bring a healthy snack.

July 25-29 – Under the Sea Fun! – Activity Code 100418

Campers will use a microscope to take a closer look at tidepool vegetation and animal species, learn about a sensor to determine the differences between salt water and fresh water, complete an array of ocean-themed art projects, and learn fun sing-a-long ocean songs. Campers should bring a healthy snack.

August 22-26 – Artsy Science – Activity Code 100417

The arts and science collide as we mold our own plaster creations, concoct super groovy glitter slime, make our own paper directly from pulp, design and erupt artsy volcanoes, create some out-of-this-world paintings, and more! Campers should bring a healthy snack.
