



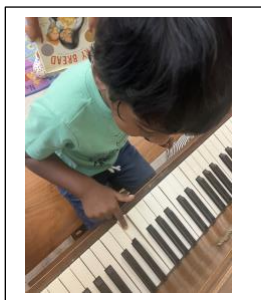
Tiny Tots International Preschool Classes
