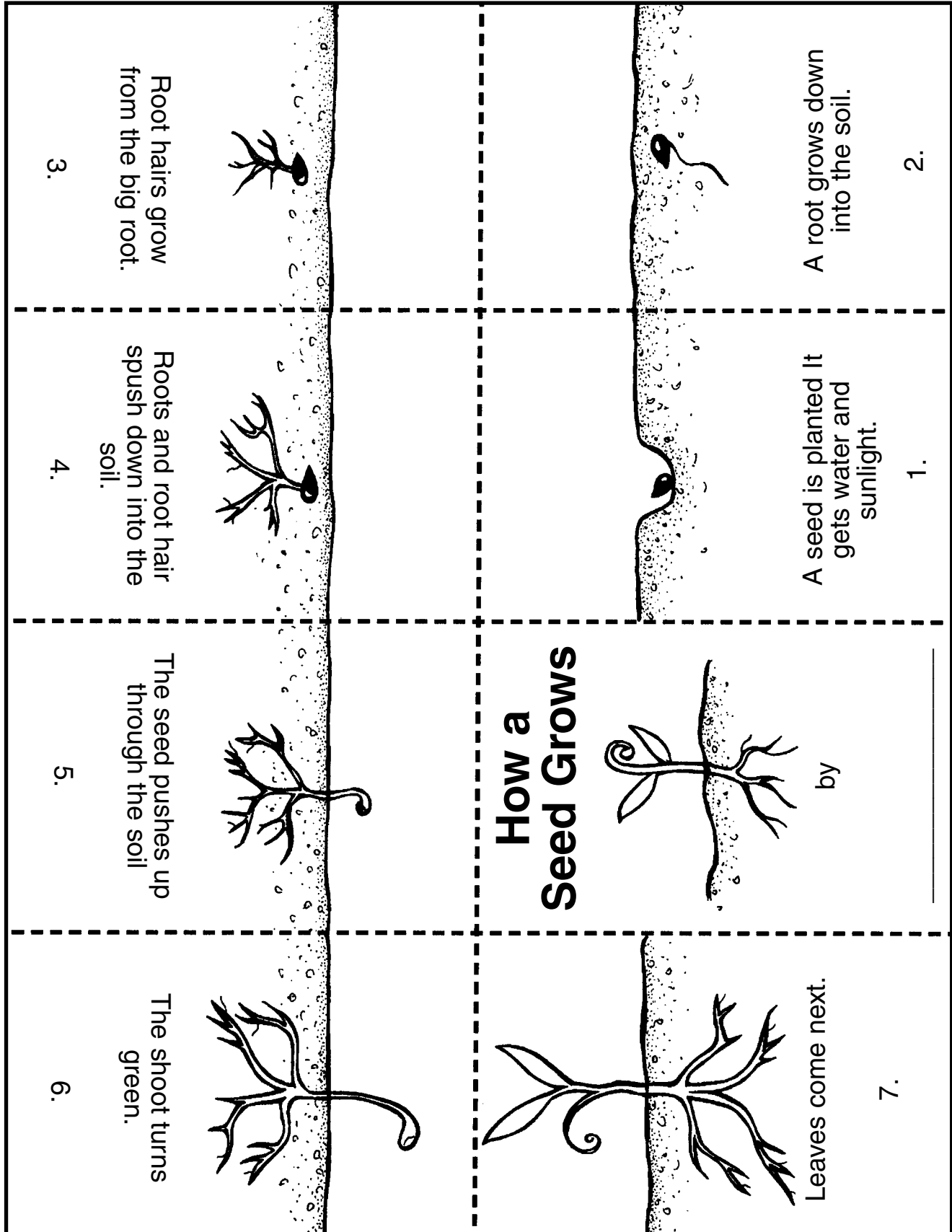


How a Seed Grows - Little Book



Making a Little Book

Make enough copies of the little book for the whole class. Cut out along the solid lines and follow the directions below.

1. Fold the page in half **lengthwise**.
2. Fold in half.
3. Fold in half again.
4. Unfold the paper; you will have eight sections.
5. Fold the page in half along the **width**.
6. Cut or tear along the center crease from the folded edge along the first box.
7. Open up the paper. It should look like diagram 7.
8. Fold it lengthwise once again.
9. Push the end sections together to fold into a little book with four pages.
10. Have the children color the pictures. Let them take turns reading the book to a partner, an older student, a parent volunteer, or to you. After working with the book for a couple days, they may take it home to read to a family member.

To make a little book without the pattern, start with a clean sheet of drawing paper or typing paper. Follow the directions, beginning with number one above. The children can write their own stories and draw pictures.
