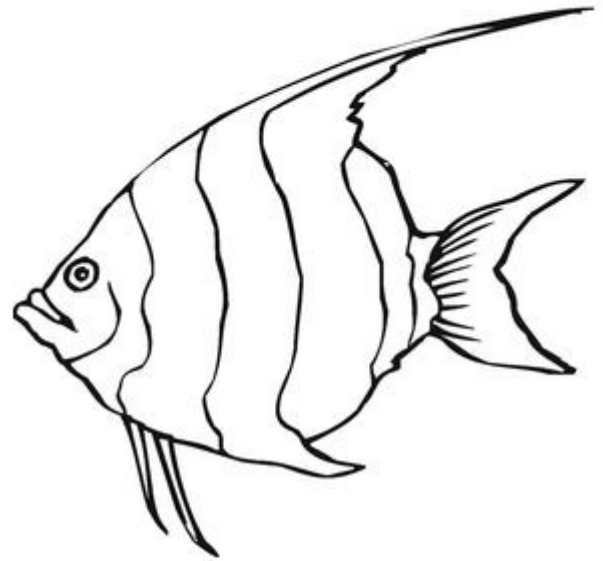
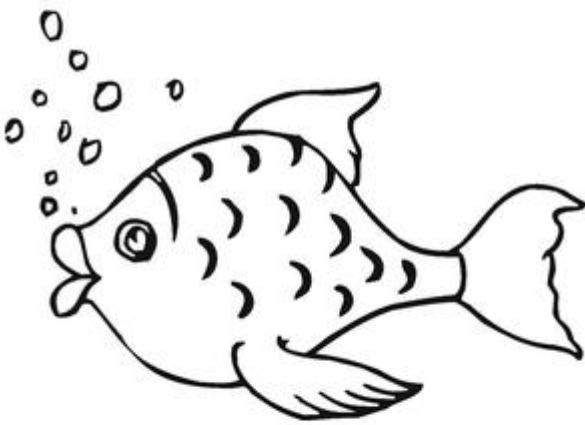


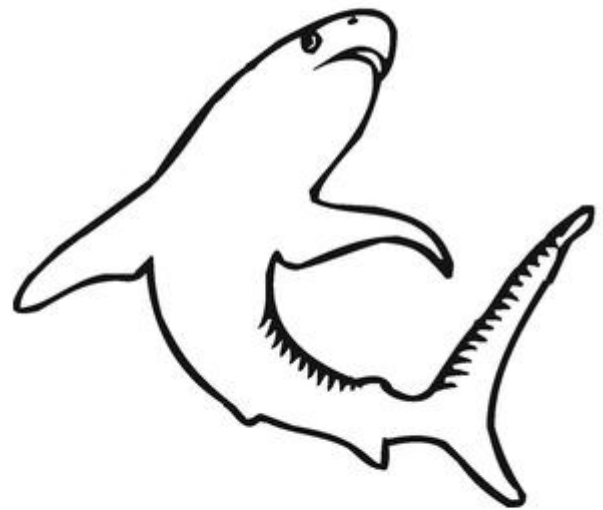
What makes a fish a fish?



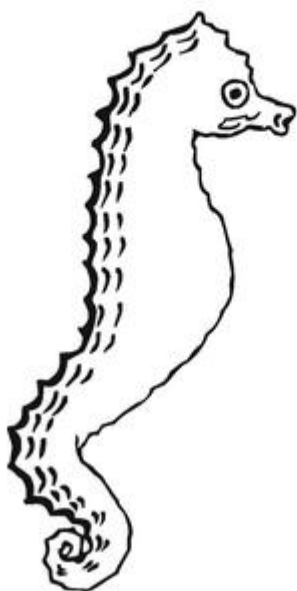
All fish are cold blooded animals that live in the water.



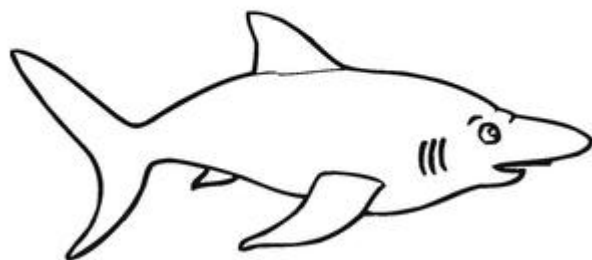
Fish have backbones, fins, and gills. There are more than 32,000 different species of fish!



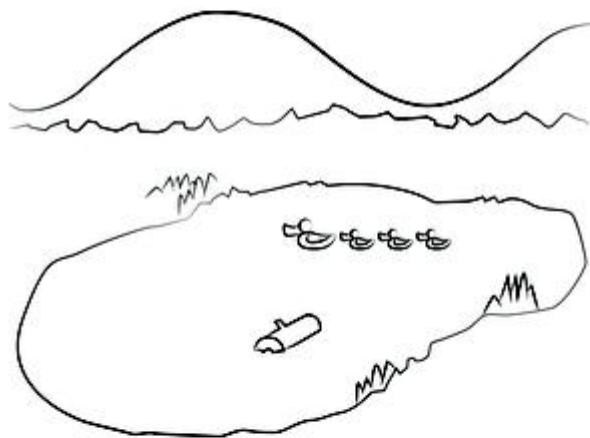
Fish come in all sorts of colors and sizes. Some are really big and some are teeny tiny.
